



## INTRODUCTION

A programme of the event has been created this year to hopefully help spectators find their way around, this includes recommended spectator points and relevant access information for each leg, there is also a time schedule of when the first car is expected at each stage, please ensure you are in place **at least 30 minutes** before the first car (It is a MSUK requirement)

The event is run over 2 days with 4 stages Friday afternoon and 8 stages Friday evening, there will be 8 stages both on the Saturday morning and afternoon giving us 28 special stages and approximately 50 stage miles.

We will be running Super Rally rules for competitors who may unfortunately go out of the main rally who wish to rejoin.

We would like to say thank you to Les Beaucamps High School for giving us the use of the School for the Service Area and Rally HQ. It should be noted that children must be under supervision at all times and **NO** dogs are allowed on the premises. ([What3Words oils.cascade.project](http://What3Words.oils.cascade.project))

Service Area opens at 08.00 on Friday 20th February.

The first of the Rally Cars will be leaving to go down to the Peninsula Hotel ([What3Words designing.gullet.flighty](http://What3Words.designing.gullet.flighty)) at 11.40 for the Ceremonial Start where Andy Priaulx MBE will be setting the cars off to go to the first of the 4 Afternoon Stages with Car 1 leaving at 12.35.

There will be a break before the 8 Night Stages where cars will have returned back to the Service Area before setting off again for the evening leg with the first car leaving service at 18.20.

After the Night Stages all the Rally Cars will return to Service and there will be Parc Ferme Overnight from 23.00.

On the Saturday Morning service opens at 07.00 with the Rally restarting at 07.49 Competitors will complete 8 Stages in the Morning.

There will be a lunch break before the start of the Afternoon Stages where again another 8 Stages will be completed with the Ceremonial Finish being held at Rally HQ Les Beaucamps High School at Approx 16.56

## POLITE NOTICE TO ALL SPECTATORS

- We have marked on the Spectator maps the designated viewing areas and parking, however should you choose to watch from any other areas PLEASE ensure that you are not walking on competitive stages. Cars will be travelling at high speeds and spectators are **NOT** to walk on the rally route
- We kindly request that all spectators are in place **at least 30 Minutes before the first car** is due it is a MSUK requirement (see schedule of times of first car)
- With regards to parking please ensure that you are not parked on private property, drives or Farmers land, do not block entrances and ensure that you leave access for residents to go in/out of their properties
- Spectators are reminded that motorsport can be dangerous and despite us taking all reasonable precautions, unavoidable accidents can happen. You are present at your own risk.
- We ask that you acknowledge and respect all instructions of safety marshals, in relation to your safety and that of others, please do not be rude or abusive

## **SAFETY CAR SCHEDULE**

**STAGE SET UP** - Goes into stage 45 minutes before the first Rally Car and puts in place all the tapes and signage, makes box junctions and puts out barriers etc

**EVENT STEWARDS** - Drive through the stage but only prior to the first running of the stage, they need to know the stages so they can assist the Motorsport UK Steward

**CAR 000 STAGE/SPECTATOR SAFETY** - Travels at a slower non-rally speed and they check the basic setup of the stage, including marshal positions and spectator management. It confirms the stage is ready for the subsequent safety checks.

**SAFETY DELEGATE DELTA 1** - Drives through 20 minutes before first Rally Car to ensure the public, volunteers and competitors are safe and the event complies with the safety requirements of the governing body Motorsport UK

**CAR 00 SAFETY CAR** - 15 minutes before first Rally Car the crew reports back on the condition of the stage and any issues that might have arisen since the initial setup was checked.

**CAR 0 (Course opening car)** - 5 minutes before the first Rally Car starts Car 0 is driven at a near-competitive speed to assess the actual driving conditions and verify that the stage is completely safe for the competitors. The crew provides a final confirmation to rally control that everything is clear.

**955 CAR (WAS SWEEPER CAR)** - Follows after last Rally Car has gone through, Its main purpose is to ensure all competitors are accounted for and assist any that have retired or are stuck on the stage


**INTERIM CAR** - After the final run the sweeper car will go through followed by the Rescue/Ambulance/Recovery  
They will be followed by the Interim car with red lights to open the road and advise the marshals to stand down

(If there is a gap of 20 minutes the Interim car will drive through the stage)

A safety car will be sent into the stage to move residents in and out of the stage as necessary
